



Pre Deployment Preparation works

A part of our service is the ability to prepare and register a clean site before we deploy equipment on a site.

All these works are done on an “at cost” basis.

Our staff have over between 5 – 10 years removal or paint out experience and it is a critical part of the shut down process for several reasons.

- We deploy our apprehension equipment typically between 3.00am and 6.00am on site and we need a clean site once the gear is activated.
- We register the site with Police as “clean” at that time so once new offenders offend, it is a simple task to marry offender to tag which in turn leads to his hundred or so additional incidents through the city.
- To reduce the waste of our time waiting for contractors to get around to doing what we need done, when we need it done. This has in the past been a hurdle that frustrates our time lines and processes.

Post audit we typically take control of 10 -20 locations for equipment, monitoring and prep and touch ups until that site has seen multiple offenders caught and we move the equipment.

The clean up works might be on Council property, private or other dependant on the site. It should be considered that the cost to clean and prep the site is minimal for the returns you are going to experience.

If you elect for the full graffiti shut down process we would monitor these sites on a day to day basis along with a set route through the various suburbs to take in what is occurring on a night to night basis.
